KubeCon + CloudNativeCon Valencia was the first time we'd gathered TeamCloudNative in Europe for three years and the atmosphere felt electric. It was such a great opportunity to greet our old



friends and welcome many new folks to the family.

It was exciting for me personally to see how much this incredible community has evolved since my first KubeCon + CloudNativeCon in 2016 when just 1,500 of us gathered together. In Valencia, we had more than 7,000 folks joining in-person plus 11,000 virtually! And what's more, 65% of you were first-time attendees.

In fact, we had a lot of firsts in Valencia. Boeing joined us as a platinum member – the first aerospace organization to join CNCF. ### SPEAKER DIVERSITY

The schedule was curated by conference co-chairs, Ricardo Rocha of CERN, Emily Fox of Apple, and Jasmine James of Twitter. The co-chairs selected 99 subject matter experts to form the program committee, and 36 experienced practitioners for the track chair selection committee, including project maintainers, active community members, and highly rated presenters from past events.

Talks are selected by the program committee through a rigorous, non-bias process where they are randomly assigned submissions CNCF enforces guidelines on gender and diversity equality among our speakers, including not accepting all-male panels.



standardized, simplified set of APIs for working with Kubernetes itself.

This week, at the KubeCon+CloudNativeCon EU, the open source project revealed that is has been working on an extension, Envoy Gateway, that would equip the Envoy reverse proxy to be a network gateway, allowing it to not only direct internal microservices traffic, but also to manage external traffic coming into the network. Kubernetes is the initial target.

The idea behind the Envoy Gateway is to provide "a simplified deployment model and API layer aimed at lighter use cases," explained Envoy creator Mat Klein, in a blog post.

Originally created for Lyft, Envoy was released as open source in 2016 and has been primarily used to build service meshes (often with Istio, another CNCF project) that help cloud native apps communicate with one another by way of sidecars. **Container Journal** - Boeing Joins Cloud Native Computing Foundation as a Platinum Member



### MASK MANDATE


As many are aware we ran into some issues onsite related to COVID-19 and the mask mandate, one of which was a general local staffing issue which is being felt on a global scale. This was reflected in a reduced number of taxis available, in the number of vendor staff working catering, and in many other places around the city and the event. This was exacerbated by a Spanish law that no Spanish employer could require an employee to wear a mask.

When Spain dropped its mask mandate on April 7 and put this law into effect (which we discovered would affect large groups on April 20) it resulted in a further reduction in local staffing for the event. Our vendors were only able to secure folx who would voluntarily wear a mask. This resulted in even lower staffing levels on-site which we know affected the attendee experience. With all of this taking place in the several weeks prior to the event, it was difficult to produce the event as our community expects.

Vendors were not the only challenge. A greater number of attendees were reluctant to comply with the mask

mandate than we saw at our North America event last November. Events staff did their best to maintain enforcement, despite reduced staff, changing laws, and general mask fatigue.

We appreciate your support and partnership in this journey and hope to be in a more stable stage of pandemic management for upcoming events with a return to the standards we are all used to.












